GENERAL INFORMATION AND RULES FOR SCHOOL YEAR EXCHANGE STUDENTS

1. All Rotary exchange students must obey Brazilian laws and the Rotary rules and regulations.
2. All Rotary exchange students must attend school regularly, seriously attempt to achieve good grades and participate fully in all school activities during your stay in the host country.
3. All Rotary exchange students must study Portuguese.
4. All Rotary exchange students must forward a written report to district 4470 *Chairman* by September 30, December 31, March 31 and June 30. Besides that, you may get in touch with the *Chairman* any time you need.
5. Any exchange student staying in Brazil must have a valid and covering insurance policy for the whole year. The policy must be according to required by Rotary International and be arranged in his home country prior to the student departure for Brazil. The insurance must cover accidents or illnesses that require hospitalization. You must bring the insurance papers with you.
6. Your host Rotary Club has agreed to give you a monthly allowance as stated on the "Guarantee Form". You must hand over to the Club Officer or Counselor **US\$ 300.00** which he will keep for you. This is to be used for emergencies. When this sum goes below US\$ 300.00, your family must send you more, to bring the balance back up to the original US\$ 300.00. This money will be returned to you at the end of your program.
7. You are expected to become an integral member of your host family, assuming duties and responsibilities normal for a person of your age.
8. Do not drive any motor vehicle.
9. Traveling during school time is allowed only for Rotary activities, to activities arranged by the school or by the host family, for trips organized by D. 4470 supervised by adult chaperones.
10. Individual journeys alone or together with other exchange students **can not be permitted**.
11. **Travel with your own parents or relatives may only be permitted during the last part of your stay in Brazil, before making plans you must ask permission for you host family, host club, and school.**
12. Students are not to form romantic attachments or go steady.
13. **ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES:** Exchange students MAY NOT drink.
14. Any student with even the slightest involvement in drugs (including marijuana) will be reported to the police and sent home as soon as police investigation permits.
15. You will be expected to attend Rotary meetings.

It should be emphasized that this District Youth Exchange Committee has absolutely no reservations about sending any student home at his or her own expense if the student does not comply with the general intent and conditions of the program and particularly a student who is in violation of any rule.
